

## Installation Instructions For 60100101 and 60100201

- 1. In order to install the rear shock tower brace, you will need to make room by jacking up the rear of the vehicle. Make sure to install a set of jack stands to sturdy the vehicle. Block the front wheels!
- 2. If your jack stands are under the chassis, you'll need to support the axle with additional jack stands or the jack for the next step or the axle will drop.
- 3. Remove the upper shock bolts, two per shock.
- 4. Carefully slide the brace on top of the frame between the chassis and the floor. On the earlier 1964-1967 models this will be tight!
- 5. Using the supplied hardware, slide the bolts through the shock, then the chassis, then the brace. Carefully install the lock nuts on top.
- 6. Torque bolts to 25-30 ft. lbs.
- 7. Carefully jack the car up and remove jackstands, then place the car on the ground.
- 8. Enjoy!
